Facts about Childhood Homelessness:

- Did you know that about 600 New Hanover County School students experience homelessness each year?
- The 2015 annual Point in Time Count found that 15.4% of homeless in the Tri-County area are children.
- The average age of a homeless person nationally is 9.
- Homeless students are:
 - 2 times as likely as their housed peers to score poorly on standardized tests in math and reading
 - 3 times more likely to be placed in special ed programs
 - 4 times more likely to drop out of school
 - 8 to 9 times more likely to repeat grades
